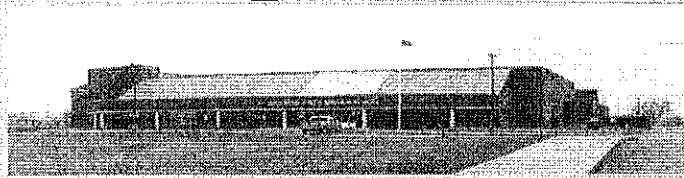
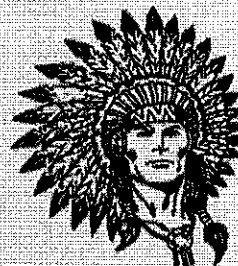

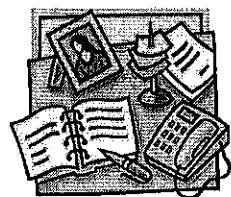

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Blueberries, they are nutritious, delicious, low in calories, great in many recipes and good for your health! As one of three fruits native to America, blueberries can be enjoyed year round. During our winter months it is summertime in Chile and Argentina and they provide fresh blueberries for us all winter. Some tips for purchasing, freezing and storing blueberries include: Purchasing- look for berries that are firm, plump, good color and dry with smooth skins. Reddish berries are not ripe yet, but can be used in cooking. Freezing- It is best to freeze before they are washed and make sure they are dry. Freeze in reusable plastic bags or freezer containers. Wash the blueberries before you eat or use. Storing- Refrigerate when you get home, wash just before you use and use within 10 days of purchasing.
