- Tell the teacher about your child's interests, strengths, learning style and/or goals.
- Tell the teacher about your hopes and dreams for your child.
- Listen to the teacher's ideas about how your child is doing in school.
- Ask the teacher about the strengths of your child and if he or she has any concerns for your child.
- Tell the teacher how you support your child's learning or ask for help if you are not sure how to provide support .
- Discuss any concerns you have about your child's learning.
- Ask how your child is doing in mastering the grade-level indicators for his or her grade.
- Ask how you can best help your child at home with his or her unique learning needs, especially with reading and math.

Students will have outside recess during the winter months as long as the temperature (including wind chill factor) is above 20 degrees. Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing (hats and gloves included) during the winter season. Keep in mind that our doors do not open until 8:35AM.
