# First Day of School

Kindergarten students start school on a staggered schedule so that teachers have small numbers while they acquaint the children with the school and each other. The schedule is as follows:

- Tues., Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> -Only Kindergarten students with last names A-L attend school.
- Wed., Sept.4<sup>th</sup> -Only Kindergarten students with last names M-Z attend school.
- Thurs., Sept. 5<sup>th</sup> –All Kindergarten students attend SChool.

# Kindergarten Assessment

On *Wednesday*, *August 21*<sup>st</sup>, student assessments have been scheduled. Your child's appointment will take approximately 1 hours. Please check your day and time on the enclosed letter.

The Ohio Legislature requires that each child entering kindergarten take the state kindergarten assessment. This kindergarten readiness assessment is used as a tool to gather information about students' pre-reading skills as they enter kindergarten.

It is extremely important that your kindergarten child attend on their assigned day and time.

- Promise to help your child every night with homework and reading. Remember, this does not mean you do it for him or her.
- Read to or with your child every night, if only for ten to fifteen minutes.

#### Car Riders



Please review the information on picking up and dropping off students that is included in this newsletter.

We understand that for kindergarten students, parents often wish to walk them into school on the first few days. For the safety of our students

PARENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO WALK THEIR

CHILD INTO THE SCHOOL. Staff will meet car riders at the front of the school and escort the students to the gym to meet their teacher.


If you are dropping your child after the 7:55 start time, parents are to walk their student into the office and sign them in.

The transportation department is arranging all bus schedules and determining rider eligibility for the upcoming school year. Bus information will be available soon at www.madriverschools.org/domain/45. This information will also be emailed to you. Please make sure your email is correct in OneView. Questions concerning student bus transportation can be addressed by calling the transportation office at 937-237-4280.

Please be advised that the bus stop times listed are approximate due to unforeseen traffic, weather, etc. Students are to be at the assigned stop at least 5 minutes before the posted times.

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#### **Stevenson Elementary's Arrival and Dismissal Process**



The map above represents the procedure for picking up and dropping students off at school. Any students walking to school will wait to cross the parking lot until the adult guard crosses them.

Any students arriving or departing school by car should come to the front of the building as indicated in the map. Drivers are asked to pull around the circle and stop in front of the building for pick-up and drop-off.

Parents are to wait in their cars for students at the end of the day. DO NOT GET OUT OF YOU CAR OR PARK ALONG THE BUILDING. Students will be lined up when they leave the building to wait for their parent to pull around. As soon as the driver pulls up to the door, the child(ren) will be called to get in the car. Then that driver will be waved on to pull away and the next car will pull up. This may take a little longer in the beginning as we get used to the process, however with practice time will improve. The important thing to remember is that this is for the safety of your child.

Students should not be at school before 7:40 a.m. as there is not supervision. Please do not drop students off prior to staff unloading students. We cannot have unsupervised students out in front of the building prior to the doors opening. Dismissal is at 2:25 p.m. Please be prompt if your student is a car rider.

If you have a change in the transportation arrangements for the day, that request must be made in writing. For example, if you child typically rides the bus and you'll be picking them up that day, please write a note and send it to your child's teacher.
