Overview

The Mad River Local Schools (MRLS) Student Success and Wellness Plan aims to address student wellness needs through targeted initiatives. These initiatives are informed by student, staff, and community survey data, as well as various needs assessments.

Initiatives:

1. **Licensed School Therapists:**
 - Place licensed school therapists in our preschool and each of the 7 school-age buildings.
 - Provide support for the social-emotional needs of students across Mad River Local Schools.
2. **District-Wide Recovery Therapists:**
 - Employ 2 district-wide recovery therapists.
 - Support licensed school therapists in the preschool and school-age buildings.
 - Provide Threat Assessment Support in the preschool and school-age buildings.
 - Build local and regional partnerships to enhance social-emotional support for students.
3. **Physical Health Support:**
 - Ensure an appropriate number of Registered Nurses (RNs) to serve the 3,800 preschool and school-age students in the district.
 - Deliver physical health services to promote student well-being.
