Children With Disabilities

The Mad River Local School District, along with other school districts throughout Ohio are participating in an effort to identify, locate and evaluate all unserved children with disabilities, under age 22.

For children through age two, a disability means a delay in one or more of the following developmental areas: adaptive behavior, cognition, communication, physical development, sensory development, and social-emotional development. For children ages three through five, a disability means a documented deficit in one or more of the developmental areas: communication, hearing, vision, motor skills, or social-emotional behavior.

For children kindergarten age and older, disability means having one or more conditions such as autism, developmental handicap, multi-handicap, orthopedically and/or other health handicap, sever behavior handicap, speech and language handicap, specific learning disability, traumatic brain injury, or visual handicap.
